### FIRST DEADLINE : November 18, 2009

If you submit a complete application on or before November 18, 2009, you will receive an award letter prior to the start of spring classes. If you submit a complete application after November 18, 2009, it may delay financial aid processing until after the start of spring classes.

### SECOND DEADLINE : December 22, 2009

Students who submit their complete application after December 22, 2009, are required to make payment arrangements with Student Accounting Services (SAS) to cover their balance upon registering for classes.

In order for your application to be considered complete, all of the following items must be completed:

- Be FULLY admitted to an eligible degree or certificate program and maintain half-time enrollment (four units for graduates, and six units for undergraduates in 16 week classes/trimester) in units that apply to your degree program
- Complete the **2009-10 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** online: [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). You **must** include our Title IV school code of **001205** in Step 6 of the FAFSA
- Submit this **completed** application to the Financial Aid Office
