Publication Date: Spring 2010

Founded in 2006, the *Golden Gate University Environmental Law Journal* (ELJ) is a scholarly legal publication that was a natural outgrowth of Golden Gate University (GGU) Law's nationally-regarded environmental law program, which includes the Environmental Law and Justice Clinic, the J.D. certificate program in environmental law, and a graduate Environmental Law L.L.M. program. We publish two issues each year: the *Symposium Edition*, which focuses on a pre-selected theme, and the *Pacific Region Edition*, which focuses on environmental law and policy issues affecting the North American Pacific region and the Asian Pacific Rim and Basin.

We look back with pride on our first few years of publication. The theme of the inaugural 2007 symposium edition was the 25th anniversary of the Warren County environmental justice protests. This was followed by a symposium edition on *Aging Dams in the West* published in 2008. The editorial board is currently finalizing the 2009 symposium edition on *Food and Farming: How We Grow What We Eat*, and has lined up an impressive roster of authors for its 2010 symposium edition on *Real Water: California's Water Supply Law Turns Ten*. Our previous pacific region editions have featured high-caliber articles on such diverse topics as urban parks, crematorium air pollutants, and the environmental jurisprudence of the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals.

Benefits of publishing in the *GGU Environmental Law Journal, Pacific Region Edition*, include:

- **Peer Review**: In addition to receiving the attention of a skilled student editorial board, articles accepted for publication are peer reviewed by the *GGU Environmental Law Journal's* faculty editor, Associate Professor Paul Stanton Kibel. Professor Kibel is the author of numerous scholarly articles and books on environmental law and a former environmental partner with Fitzgerald, Abbott & Beardsley, where he is currently of counsel.
- **Expedited Decisions**: The *GGU Environmental Law Journal's* editorial board strives to do an initial review within days of receiving a submission and to provide prompt responses to submitters.
- **Exposure**: Articles published in the *GGU Environmental Law Journal* are available in bound copy to a growing subscription base and on Westlaw, LexisNexis, and Hein Online. We provide a generous number of article offprints for our authors.


**GGU Environmental Law Journal


