

GGU/UPX Paris Summer Comparative Law Program 2008

Tuition and Costs

US and Canadian students pay \$5,800 (US), which includes:

- Tuition for 4 semester units of credit at \$1,090/unit (total = \$4,360)
- Room at CIUP (students finding their own housing may reduce payment by \$1,000)
- Field trip to Brussels (\$200)
- Books and readers (\$240)
- Receptions with French lawyers, judges and government officials (included)
- Welcome dinners, receptions, and cruise on the Seine (included)
- A Paris transit pass (included)
- French liability insurance (included)

The \$250 non-refundable application fee will be credited toward tuition.

Students are responsible for:

- Their own transportation to and from Paris.
- Nearly all meals. (Subsidized student meals are available at CIUP and UPX for under \$6.00)
