Regular Adjunct Faculty is defined as active Adjuncts who have taught a minimum of three class-sections in the previous three academic years. Active for the purposes of this grant means eligible to continue to teach. (Adjunct Faculty, themselves who do not qualify for or choose to decline the GGU Employee Educational Assistance Program are eligible for this grant).

If I am receiving outside sources to cover tuition costs, such as Employer Reimbursement, VA benefits, Scholarships, and/or Grants, all sources received may not exceed tuition costs for the term.
