The statement may also address an applicant's ethnicity/race, employment history, volunteer experience, sexual orientation and gender identity, socioeconomic and cultural backgrounds, and any personal characteristics that you bring to the law school community. You must certify at the conclusion of your statement that you are the author and did not receive undue assistance.

You may also submit a one page addendum that will assist the admissions committee in assessing your record.
