

## How To Read Your Law School Program Evaluation Report

The evaluation report is generated from the University's student information system. It shows the requirements for your degree program, and your progress towards fulfilling those requirements. When there are specific course requirements, the report shows what courses have been used to fulfill those requirements whether they are courses transferred in from another institution or courses completed at GGU Law School. You should review your evaluation report prior to the registering for each term to determine which courses you should take in order to complete your degree program.

### Explanation of the sample program evaluation report below:

1. Your degree program title, including major for LLM students.
2. The catalog year in which you were admitted. Program requirements change from time to time, and the requirements that were in effect the year you were admitted are the ones you must fulfill to complete your degree.
3. Your anticipated degree completion date. It is important that this date be as accurate as possible, especially for JD students who receive access to Priority Registration based on this date. If the date on your report is incorrect, send a message to [lawreg@ggu.edu](mailto:lawreg@ggu.edu) and we will update your records.
4. Your preferred e-mail address. If this address is not correct, you may update it via GGU4YOU. Many departments in the Law School and University use this address to communicate with you, so please keep it up to date.
5. A note regarding the grades that appear on your evaluation report.
6. Your program status. The status will be "In Progress" while you are working on the degree requirements. In your last semester/term, your status should be "Pending." When all requirements have been completed, your status will be "Complete."
7. Number of credits that must be completed at GGU School of Law.
8. The GPA you must achieve at GGU School of Law. This will generally be the same as your "overall" GPA.
9. Number of credits required to complete your degree program.  
*Current Earned:* Number of credits earned at GGU or transferred in from other institutions.  
*Current Remaining:* The number of credits you have left to earn.  
*Anticipated Additional:* The number of credits you are enrolled in which have not been graded.  
*Anticipated Remaining:* The number of credits remaining assuming you successfully complete all of the courses that are not graded.
10. Overall GPA requirement and your current overall GPA.
11. Legend of individual requirement statuses. Each requirement is numbered and will have one of these status codes next to it.
12. The required courses for each program will appear first.
13. For JD programs, there is an additional GPA requirement for the required courses. Your required courses GPA will appear first followed by the minimum GPA needed (e.g. your GPA / Required GPA).
14. Any additional course requirements will appear second followed by the elective course requirement.
15. Any additional general requirements will appear last.
16. Other courses that you have completed at the Law School or transferred into the Law School which are not being used to fulfill degree requirements will appear here.
17. These notes provide additional explanation regarding how specific courses were applied to the requirements. Generally they can be ignored.
